A wind gust of 72 MPH was recorded by an automated sensor at Holman Field at 6:00 PM CDT. Numerous trees and power lines were downed from St. Anthony Park to the State Fairgrounds to the State Capitol including the southern portion of Como Park and the Midway area. A handful of buildings and signs at the fairgrounds were damaged. Four homes, a large porch, a fence, and a car near Como Park were significantly damaged by felled trees. In downtown about 60 windows were broken on buildings and skyways and a large billboard was downed onto power lines. Two of four clock faces were damaged on top of Landmark Center. The high winds also caused two barges to break loose on the Mississippi River and bump into the Robert Street Bridge.

Heavy rain that fell between 10 PM CDT on the 29th and 3 AM on the 30th caused widespread flooding of roads, fields, and waterways across Redwood and southern Renville counties. In Renville County, portions of County Road 15 along the Minnesota River near between Franklin and Fairfax were severely eroded. A mudslide was reported on County Road 15 near Morton. Several other ditches and gravel roads were eroded across the southern portion of the county. Buffalo Creek nearly overflowed. Portions of county roads 4 and 20 were closed by high water. A total of 8 inches of rain was reported near Franklin. In Redwood County, significant flooding was reported in Redwood Falls, Wabasso, and Morgan. Eight county roads had to be closed after water flowed over them. In Redwood Falls the Minnesota River crested 2 feet above flood stage. The Redwood River, the Cottonwood River, and Ramsey Creek also ran high. Ramsey Park and the sway back bridge were closed by high water in addition to nearby County Road 31. Numerous basements were flooded across the city. In Morgan, many city residents reported flooded basements and nearby gravel roads were washed out. Farmers outside of town had to replant beans and corn after their fields flooded. The highest rainfall totals included 8 inches in New Avon Township, 7 inches in Wabasso, and 5 inches in Redwood Falls. **Sherburne County** Clear Lake to 1 NE Clear Lake Tornado (F0) 30 A weak tornado was reported by trained spotters just north of the intersection of Highway 10 and County Road 6. It dissipated northeast of town a short time later with little if any damage reported. **Morrison County** 5 SE Royalton 30 1700CST **Funnel Cloud Goodhue County** 1 E Goodhue A funnel cloud was reported just east of Goodhue by the fire department. The funnel cloud touched down later about 6 miles east of Zumbrota.
