

Lake Wales vicinity. **BOK MOUNTAIN LAKE SANCTUARY AND SINGING TOWER**, 2 mi. N of Lake Wales, 1920, Milton B. Medary, architect. Steel frame, brick infill, coquina stone and marble facing, 20st-high tower rectangular, full-height buttresses terminating in sculpted pinnacles, large pointed arched openings in octagonal top section, balcony, pointed arched entrance; elaborately carved screens friezes and ornamentation depicting fables and natural and human scenes; sundial; ornate interior, large imported carillon, landscaping by Frederick Law Olmsted, Jr. Modernistic. Sanctuary and memorial planned by Edward W. Bok author, and editor of *Ladies Home Journal*; tower won 1929 American Institute of Architects Gold Metal. *Private*.
