SUBJECT: Update of HCPCS Codes and File Names, Descriptions and Instructions for Retrieving the 2006 ASC HCPCS Deletions, Additions, and Master Listing

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: This Change Request serves two purposes. It contains the updated Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes for ASCs for services performed on or after January 1, 2006, along with their payment groups. It also provides instructions for contractors to retrieve the new data via the CMS Mainframe Telecommunications System on or after the specified retrieval date.

The CMS' Division of Data Systems (DDS) will release the files listed below. This instruction provides contractors with file names and instructions on how to retrieve these files from the CMS Mainframe Telecommunications System.

B. Policy: The additions and deletions from the ASC list are the result of changes in the American Medical Association (AMA) Physician's Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) for 2006. Attachment A to this instruction lists the additions and deletions. These changes shall not be publicized until after the publication of the AMA's 2006 CPT-4 codes which usually occurs by the first of November.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECEIVING 2006 AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTER (ASC) HCPCS CODE DELETIONS/ADDITIONS AND MASTER LISTING VIA CMS' MAINFRAME TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM

Listed below are instructions for receiving the 2006 ASC Code HCPCS deletions/additions and master listing along with their respective payment groups via the CMS mainframe telecommunications system. In order not to incur additional transmission cost, transmission must occur during the evening hours, specifically after 8:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time (EST).

Listed below are the most common problems encountered when carriers/intermediaries receive data via the CMS mainframe telecommunications system:

- o Omission or change of NEWNAME parameter. Omission of this parameter makes it extremely difficult and cumbersome for CMS to access CMTS log to verify transmission success/failure. See the following NEWNAME parameters:
- o Omission or change of STARTT parameter. This parameter establishes the starting time for the batch job. As stated earlier, transmission must occur during the evening hours. Setting the STARTT to 20:00:00 hours assures that transmission will not commence prior to 8:00 PM EST.

The following is the JCL required for setting up a CMTS transmission of the 2006 Part B Pricing Files file from the CMS Data Center.
