



GARRETT COUNTY 2001 AGRICULTURAL PROFILE

Garrett County is the western most county in the state. It ranks first in total area and second in land area (the difference being water area). Garrett is called tableland because of the plateau. The average elevation is 2,500 feet. Garrett County is bordered on the south and west by West Virginia, and on the east by Allegany County.

Garrett is truly a four seasons county with spring, cool summer, colorful fall and plenty of snow for winter. The county population of 29,846 swells with seasonal tourists.

Garrett County is basically a dairy and livestock area because of the climate, growing season, soil type and topography. It presently ranks fifth in the state in dairy production with the bulk of milk finding a Pennsylvania market.

Maple syrup production is still a unique industry of Garrett County, with 10 to 15 sugar bushes still operating.
