

An extreme hardship would exist for broadcasters if they are to locate their main studio in the city of license. Broadcasters have invested many thousands of dollars for studio and office equipment and hired professionals to work and live around their present studio and office operations.

In our case, the city of license is not in the most desirable location for such a facility as well as an area where employees would feel comfortable in living.

There is no need to uproot a business of employees from their home and surroundings when no real good can come of it.

A distance of 10 minutes does not make you not understand the city of license. Plus, our coverage is such that our contour extends to more than just the one city of license but many cities and many different people

I strongly oppose any move to mandate a change of studio to the city of license.

The needs of the community are more important than the needs of just one city. You don't have to live, work or have a studio in the city of license to understand and develop programming to meet those needs.
