Report Highlights:

On December 30, 2005, the Ministry of Finance and Economy (MOFE) announced CY 2006 Emergency Tariffs for 44 imported agriculture and livestock products including mung beans, red beans, soybeans, etc. The announcement noted that emergency tariff rate revisions are intended to prevent surges in imports from hurting local industries. This revision is effective as of January 1 and will remain in place until December 31, 2006. This report provides changes of basic trigger volumes and emergency tariffs for 2005 and 2006.

Note 2/ The base trigger volume refers to the volume obtained by multiplying the coefficient classified in each of the following subparagraphs (hereinafter referred to as " base trigger coefficient") by the average import quantity of the preceding three years for which data are available and by summing up the changed quantity in comparison with the domestic consumption of the relevant goods during the preceding year. If the base trigger volume is below 105 percent of the average import quantity of the preceding three years, the base trigger volume shall be 105 percent of the average import quantity of the preceding three years.

- 1. If the percentage of the import quantity in the domestic consumption of the relevant goods for the preceding three years in which data are available (hereinafter referred to as "market share") is below 10 percent: 125 percent
- 2. If the market share is above 10 percent and below 30 percent: 110 percent
- 3. If the market share exceeds 30 percent: 105 percent and
- 4. If the market share is incalculable: 125 percent
