Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Mixtures containing n-butyl-1,2-benzisothiazolin-3-one (Butyl benzisothiazoline) (CAS No. 4299-07-4) and application adjuvants (provided for in subheadings 3808.92.50 or 3808.99.08).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The synthetic organic chemical, butyl benzisothiazoline, is the active ingredient in two formulated mixtures that are used as biocides to control fungi and bacteria in natural rubber and plastics products made from a variety of polymers. One formulated biocidal product, Densil DG45, contains 40-50 % butyl benzisothiazoline along with application adjuvants (propylene glycol) and is classified under subheading 3808.92.50. The second formulated biocidal product, Vanquish 100, contains 90-100 % butyl benzisothiazoline along with application adjuvants and is classified under HTS subheading 3808.99.08. Both formulated butyl benzisothiazoline products are imported as such from the United Kingdom.

Technical comments:⁴

The Commission staff suggests that the article description on page 1 of this report be used in the proposed new heading in order to provide the correct spelling of the common chemical name.

The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
