How does it work?

Daily: If you prefer daily updates of wildlife disease news, sign up to have them delivered directly to your email inbox. Headlines, source information, and a snippet of each article, along with links to each full article are delivered daily. You may unsubscribe at anytime.

Weekly: Weekly updates are delivered via email by the Wildlife Health Listsery on Fridays, providing the week's news headlines with links to the respective daily posts. You may unsubscribe at any

At Your Leisure: Subscribe to the Wildlife Disease News Digest RSS feed to view daily news digest posts through your news feed aggregator as you please, or simply visit the Wildlife Disease News Digest Webpage at any time to view recent and past news entries, as well as for links to additional resources.
