

Spikes more or less approximate

Perigynia ca 5 mm long, elliptic or ovate, more or less inflated and obcompressed below the bidentate beak

Distribution: Endemic to the Indian Valley area of Adams County, Idaho.

Habitat: Dry gumbo or gravelly soils. **Phenology:** June through July.

Look-alikes: Most similar to *C. raynoldsii* but the heads not dense and spikes more or less approximate. The perigynia ca 5 mm long, elliptic or ovate, more or less inflated and with a bidentate beak to 1 mm long, obcom-

pressed below the bidentate beak. Collected in 1999 for the first time since the original collection.
