McCollum Discusses Human Rights with Dalai Lama

Rep. Betty McCollum met with His Holiness, the 14th Dalai Lama of Tibet. Testifying before the House Committee on International Relations, the Dalai Lama addressed issues of human rights in Tibet and around the world.

"The Tibetan people have endured over a half-century of religious persecution, inhumane prisons and violence," said McCollum. "Through this, the Dalai Lama's steadfast leadership and commitment to peace and bringing social change has been a model for the world. His perseverance in defending human rights worldwide is an inspiration."

As a member of the Congressional Human Rights Caucus and the Subcommittee on International Terrorism, Nonproliferation and Human Rights, McCollum is directly working to promote and protect internationally recognized human rights.

"Defense of political, religious and human rights requires constant vigilance. The United States has an opportunity to work alongside leaders such as the Dalai Lama and use our influence to affect other countries' practices and policies that violate human rights around the globe," McCollum said.

The Dalai Lama is the exiled spiritual and political leader of six million Tibetans and was awarded the 1989 Nobel Peace Prize for his work on global human rights for his ceaseless efforts to free his country from Chinese rule.
