- 1. After this procedure, you may have any of the following:
 - increased gas
 - bloating
 - cramping
 - mild abdominal discomfort
 - small amount of rectal bleeding
- 2. If you have any of the following, notify your doctor:
 - severe abdominal pain lasting more than 1 hour
 - large amount of rectal bleeding
 - fever or chills
