

Agua Dulce. **VASQUEZ ROCKS**, 200 B.C.-1800 A.D.. Area contains rock shelters, flaking sites, multifunctional sites, pictographs, and a cemetery site. By the time of Spanish contact Vasquez Rocks was occupied by the Alliklik Indians (a Shoshonean tribe) and was a major settlement in the Upper Santa Clara River Valley region. Site survey and limited excavations, 1968-1971, by San Fernando Valley State College and the Los Angeles County Museum of Natural History. *County/private.*
