Rawlins Field Office decision letter – March 30, 2001 (same as before)

Cabot requested Wyoming BLM State Director Review of 3/30/01 decision - April 25, 2001

State Director Review held - May 18, 2001

State Director issued decision – June 6, 2001 (supports Cabot's position)

APD approved by Rawlins Field Office - June 29, 2001

Well "spud" – August 8, 2001

Reason for bringing project to the task force's attention: Cabot would like – expedited APD approval process; application of BLM permitting process benchmarking study to all BLM field offices; consistent application of IDP limitations; creation and enforcement of time limits on EIS process. Cabot also notes significant understaffing of BLM field offices causing delay in processing of applications and permits.
