Simmons-Edwards House 12–14 Legare Street, Charleston

Constructed ca. 1800, this three-story brick dwelling is one of Charleston's finest examples of a single house. The house is also notable in a city of notable houses for its fine wrought-iron decoration and for its landscaping. As is typical of Charleston's high-style single houses, the door from the sidewalk does not lead directly into the house, but onto the first level of the two-story piazza.
