Wetlands Conservation Council
(Council) reported to the Migratory Bird
Conservation Commission (Commission) the
51 projects in 29 states it had selected for
funding under the North American
Wetlands Conservation Act Small Grants
Program. The Council selected these projects
at its meeting in March. Today, the Council
also recommended eight Canadian projects
to the Commission for final funding approval
under the Act's Standard Grants Program.
The tables below contain summary data on
each project.

The Act is nonregulatory and calls for voluntary partnerships to develop and implement wetlands conservation projects to benefit migratory birds and other wildlife.
