Bodega Bay vicinity. **BODEGA BAY**, Prehistoric (Middle and Late Horizon), protohistoric, historic. Site of prehistoric permanent villages, temporary camps, and processing stations associated with procurement of shellfish, kelp, marine mammals. Later center for production of clamshell disc beads which played important role in economic system of Pomo and Coast Miwok Indians. After visits by Lt. Bodega (1779) and Vancouver (1792) area was occupied by Russian fur traders and served as their shipbuilding and agricultural center (1811-1841). *Private*.
