

Inger vicinity. **OLD CUT FOOT SIOUX RANGER STATION**, S of Inger off MN 46 in Chippewa National Forest, 1904. Log construction, 1 story, rectangular, shingled gabled roof, garage door cut in one gable end, 1913; enclosed by plywood building, 1969. One of the oldest outposts built to allow closer supervision of national forests. Built at end of prehistoric mound (see also Turtle Oracle Mound, MN) and portage campsite. Museum. *Federal/USFS*.
