### Overview














### Hotel Accommodation



**Train:** Amtrak services from New York, Philadelphia and Baltimore.



#### **Abstract Guidelines**

**Title:** The title should be brief and clearly capitalized. Omit author degrees, titles and institutional appointments. Underline the authors names; initials precede last names. Specify name and location of institute where research was conducted.

#### **Abstract Structure**

The abstract should be a maximum of **350 words** and structured as follows:

- A sentence stating the purpose of the study
- A brief description of the methods involved, if pertinent
- A concise summary of the results
- A statement of the conclusions reached.

#### **Abstract Style**

- Begin the body of the abstract on a new line that is indented three spaces
- Short abstracts should be centered within the page
- Leave no top or left margins
- Please use fonts from 10–12 points in size
