MAJOR FLOOR ACTIONS OF THE DAY**

**SENATE**

**ALLEN (R-VA)** introduced **S.1110** for himself and others to amend the **Federal Hazardous Substances Act** to require engine coolant and antifreeze to contain a bittering agent in order to render the coolant or antifreeze unpalatable. (S5851)

**HOUSE**

**YOUNG (R-AK)** introduced **H.R.2566** for himself and others to provide an extension of highway, highway safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other programs funded out of the Highway Trust Fund pending enactment of a law reauthorizing the **Transportation Equity Act** for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. (H3892)

**ACKERMAN (D-NY)** introduced **H.R.2567** for himself and others to amend the **Federal Hazardous Substance Act** to require engine coolant and antifreeze to contain a bittering agent so as to render it unpalatable. (H3892)

**ANDREWS (D-NJ)** introduced **H.R.2571** to require the establishment of programs by the **Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency**, the Director of the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health, and the Secretary of Health and Human Services to improve indoor air quality in schools and other buildings. (H3892)
