Economic Data Reports

• Due <u>June 28</u> from catcher vessel and catcher/processor owners, stationary floating crab processors, and shoreside processors.

Fee Payments – Rationalization Program

• Due July 31 from Registered Crab Receivers (RCRs)

Annual Applications:

- Annual Application for Crab IFQ/IPQ Permit due August 1
- □ Annual Application for Crab Harvesting Cooperative due <u>August 1</u>

Registered Crab Receiver (RCR) :

RCR permit prior to receiving crab
Interagency Electronic Reporting System (IERS) Application for User ID (Acquire prior to first receipt of CR crab)

- Crab Monitoring Plan (Submit and receive approval prior to first receipt of CR crab)
- □ State approved scale/printer (acquire prior to first receipt of CR crab)

Arbitration System

- CVO QS and PQS holders must join an Arbitration Organization by <u>May 1</u>.
- Arbitration Organizations submit Annual Arbitration Organization Report to NMFS by May 1.
- □ Arbitration Organizations select the Market Analyst, Formula Arbitrator, and Contract Arbitrators and notify NMFS by June 1.
- □ The Market Report produced by the Market Analyst and Non-Binding Price Formula produced by the Formula Arbitrator must be completed and a copy provided to NMFS by:

June 25 for the Aleutian Island golden king crab fishery, and

August 25 for the red king crab, Tanner, and snow crab fisheries.

Conclude all Binding Arbitrations by the end of the crab fishing year, June 30.
