SECTION I (Page 1) - All items in this section must be completed.

1-2. Name and address must agree with the information in the FCC's records for the assigned Applicant (Grantee) Code, when an Applicant (Grantee) Code has been previously assigned.

Name change - Check the "change box" only if a legal name or an address change has occurred that has not been reported. If a name change has occurred, include a separate letter explaining the circumstances resulting in the name change. Do not check the box if a name and/or address change will occur in the future. See 47 CFR §2.934 for reporting requirements for name and/or address changes.

3.(a) Enter the three character Applicant(Grantee) Code assigned by the FCC. If no Code has been assigned, see *Paragraph E* for obtaining a Code *prior* to filing Form 731 for an equipment authorization.

Pursuant to 47 CFR §2.926, a Code may be requested concurrent with a request for equipment authorization on the *same* FCC Form 731. If this option is selected, in addition to a fee for the equipment authorization, a fee for assignment of the Applicant (Grantee) Code is required. Upon receipt of the "Notification of Applicant(Grantee) Code Assignment" from the Application Processing Branch, the applicant will be required to amend the original Form 731 and proposed identification label to reflect the complete proposed FCC Identifier (FCC ID). Applicants selecting this option will therefore experience an administrative processing delay of the application.

- 3.(b) The Equipment Product Code (EPC) may not exceed 14 characters. The EPC may consist of any combination of capital letters, Arabic numerals, and the hyphen or dash (-). To distinguish zeroes in the EPC from the capital letter "O" show the zeroes as "a" To expedite entry of the FCC ID into the FCC's database, it is requested that applicants select an EPC that has the least number of characters that will adequately identify the equipment in this application. Example: family, series or system numbers or names.
- **4.** This item *must* be completed regardless of whether or not the applicant has an agent, or has elected to have the original Grant of Equipment Authorization (Grant), if issued, sent to another party. The FCC *will not* mail a Grant without the name, title, etc. of an individual to whose attention it should be directed.

SECTION II - FEE DATA - All fee data begins in this section. Failure to pay the appropriate fees will result in dismissal of the application. See 47 CFR $\S1.1109(c)$.

To complete these items, applicants must either refer to a copy of the fee rules, 47 CFR \S 1.1103, or the OET Fee Filing Guide. See *Paragraph C* for Fee Type Codes, and *Paragraph F* for obtaining a Fee Guide.

- **SECTION III** Use this section to continue listing fee data if *more than one* approval service is requested, or the equipment is subject to the *same* type of equipment authorization and a single Form 731 may be submitted. - 5. The payment instrument (check, money order, or bank draft) must be drawn on a United States financial institution and made payable to *Federal Communications Commission*. A third party payment instrument, or one that is post-dated more than 6 months is *not* acceptable. *See 47 CFR* §1.1110.

SECTION IV (Page 2) - Enter the FCC ID from page 1, Section I.

- **1.(a).** Electing another party to receive an *original* grant is at the sole discretion of the applicant. Complete this item if the applicant has authorized a representative to receive the original grant, or the grant is to be mailed to an address *different* from the applicant's address shown in Section I. No additional copies will be mailed to the applicant or other parties, or to another address.
- **(b).** If item 1.(a) is completed, this item must also be completed. The FCC will not mail a Grant without the name, title, etc. of an individual to receive it.
- **2.** (a)-(h). If contacts are listed in this item, the FCC will contact *only* the party(ies) listed for information, unless the FCC determines that the applicant *must* be contacted directly. The contact party(ices) must be able to provide the information that may be requested by the FCC.
- 3. If this item is answered "Yes" a fee is required for the "Request for Confidentiality" and for the requested equipment authorization. The written request for confidentiality must include a justification consistent with the requirements in 47 CFR $\S0.459(a)$ & (b). The confidentiality request must (1) specifically identify the material to be held confidential (See 47 CFR $\S0.457(d)$), and (2) the material to be held confidential, along with a copy of the request, must be placed in a sealed envelope with the name of the applicant and the FCC ID on the outside.
- **4.** If this item is answered "Yes" the applicant must notify the Application Processing Branch at the address in Paragraph A, in writing, advising of the date the application is to be granted. The equipment may not be legally marketed in the USA until the grant has been issued. See 47 CFR \$2.803 and \$2.915(c) of the rules.
- 5. If you are uncertain as to the type of equipment authorization that you should request, contact the Appliction Processing Branch at the address in *Paragraph A* for assistance. An incorrect identification of the type of equipment authorization requested may require return of the application for insufficient fee payment.
- **6.(a).** See Page 4 of these instructions for the equipment codes and classifications used by the FCC.
- **7.** Box 1 Check only for new equipment that has not been previously authorized by the FCC.
- Box 3- Check only if the equipment listed in this application has been previously authorized by the FCC. Do *not* check if the FCC ID has been changed as a result of modification of the equipment. (*Check Box 2 if the FCC ID has been changed*.) If an application is pending with the FCC under the *same* FCC ID in Section I, and the applicant wishes to file additional information, contact the Application Processing Branch at the address in *Paragraph A*, for instructions on submitting amendments to pending applications.

- 8.(a). Show the frequency/frequency range in megahertz (MHz). Example: If the frequency is 325 kilohertz (kHz), convert it to .325 megahertz.
- **8.(b).** This item applies to transmitting equipment that is subject *to Type Acceptance*, *Notification* and *Certification* (e.g., Part 15 spread spectrum transmitters).
- **8.**(c)-(d). These items apply only to equipment that is subject to *Type Acceptance*, or is transmitting equipment that is subject to *Notification*.
- **8.(e).** This item applies to digital devices that are subject to *Certification* under Part 15 of the Rules (personal computers and personal computer peripherals).
- **9.(a).** Examples of composite devices are:
 - (1) a *CB transceiver* that (a) requires assignment of the same FCC ID; (b) is subject to both Type Acceptance and Certification; and (c) requires two Form 731 filings (one for Type Acceptance and one for Certification), accompanied by required documentation (including a fee for both Type Acceptance and Certification).
 - (2) a *Part 15 transceiver* that (a) contains a transmitter and a superregenerative receiver; (b) requires assignment of the same FCC ID; (c) is subject to Certification under both Subparts B and C of Part 15; and (d) requires a fee for both the transmitter and the receiver portion of the device.

Note: A single Form 731, accompanied by required documentation for the transmitter and receiver portions may be submitted for these types of Part 15 transceivers, by listing the appropriate Fee Type Codes and fees in Sections II and III of Form 731. Example: Sections II and III of Form 731 would show the Fee Type Codes EGC and EEC and appropriate fees; Item 5, Section III would show the total fees due.

Applications for composite devices *must* be filed at the same time. The FCC *will not* issue Grant(s) of Equipment Authorization until all required applications are filed, appropriate fees paid, and all requirements for grant are met.

- **9.(b).** An example of a system where both devices require an equipment authorization is an *auto security alarm system* that
- (a) consists of a transmitter and superregenerative or superheterodyne receiver; (b) requires a different FCC ID to be assigned for *each* component of the system; and (c) requires two Form 731 filings (one for the transmitter and one for the receiver), accompanied by all required documentation (including a fee for the transmitter and a fee for the receiver).

Application(s) for the component(s) *must* be filed at the same time if the related receiver or transmitter that operates, or is marketed as part of a system, has *not* been authorized by the FCC. The FCC *will not* issue Grant(s) of Equipment Authorization until all required applications are filed, appropriate fees paid, and all requirements for grant are met.

Questions concerning the types of devices described in items 9.(a) and 9.(b), and filing procedures for these types of devices may be addressed to the FCC at the address in paragraph A.

SECTION IV (Page 3) - Enter the FCC ID from Page 1, Section I. 10.(a)-(b). Self-explanatory.

11. Enter the name of the test firm. (Test firms that perform compliance testing of equipment which is subject to Certification or Notification under Part 15, or Certification under Part 18 of the rules, must file a description of their measurement facility, pursuant to 47 CFR \$2.948.)
