U.S. CHARGÉ D'AFFAIRES, A.I. MEETS WITH JATIYA PARTY

DHAKA, MARCH 18 -- Geeta Pasi, the U.S. Chargé d'Affaires, a.i., met with Jatiya Party Chairman Lt. Gen. (Ret'd.) Hussain Muhammed Ershad and other Jatiya party leaders today. This is a continuation of Ms. Pasi's meetings with Political Party leaders.

Ms. Pasi and the Jatiya Party leaders discussed the current political situation in Bangladesh and the status of implementation of the electoral roadmap. She reiterated the United States Government's desire to see free, fair and fully participatory elections by the end of 2008 as promised by the Caretaker Government and underscored the important role the political parties will play in this process. Ms. Pasi noted the importance of dialogue between the political parties and the government in order to establish the proper conditions for holding elections.

U.S. Embassy officials meet regularly to discuss current issues in Bangladesh with political party leaders as well as with members of the government and civil society.

Ms. Pasi will meet with the leadership of other political parties, including the Bangladesh Nationalist Party, in the coming days.
