Defined:


 A plan to <u>CLOSE</u> the organizational gap between where we <u>ARE</u> and where we want to <u>BE</u>.

 An upper management-initiated process that sets specific goals and identifies measurable steps for a division or an entire organization taking into account personnel and budgetary resources.



Recruitment & Retention Statistics


145 Agencies
