Packers' Forward Purchases of Fed Cattle, 1988-97

Attached are three tables summarizing monthly and annual data the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Grain Inspection, Packers and Stockyards Administration (GIPSA) obtained from leading steer and heifer slaughtering packers on the portion of cattle they slaughtered that were obtained through forward contracts, marketing agreements and their own feeding operations between 1988 and 1997.

Data were obtained from the 4 largest and 15 largest beef packers each year through reports the firms filed with the Agency. The identity of firms may vary from year to year. The following table shows the percentage of total steer and heifer slaughter accounted by the 4 and 15 largest firms each year.

Forward contracts are contracts packers enter into for the delivery of cattle 2 or more weeks before slaughter with price determined prior to slaughter. A marketing agreement is an oral or written agreement between a packer and seller in which the seller agrees to ship all or part of its slaughter cattle to the packer when the cattle are ready for slaughter, with price determined at or after slaughter, usually by an agreed formula that may reflect live animal or carcass quality, prices paid by the packer to other sellers at the time of delivery, or publicly-reported prices. Terms of sale are not negotiated for individual lots of cattle when cattle are delivered through marketing agreements. Packer-fed cattle are cattle packers own 2 or more weeks prior to slaughter that were fed in a packer's own feeding operations or fed for the packer in a feeding operation owned by another firm (custom fed).
