I want to make notice of my vigorous opposition to allowing Federal Agencies to tap into Internet based data and VoIP services. Democracy demands that our voices, writings, and opinions can be heard both freely and anonymously. Our constitution guarantees us this right. It is not the place of the FCC or any other executive body to change this cornerstone of our democratic way of life.

I close this comment with a quote by Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglass

"As nightfall does not come at once, neither does oppression. In both instances, there is a twilight when everything remains seemingly unchanged. And it is in such twilight that we all must be most aware of change in the air, however slight, lest we become unwitting victims of the darkness."
