



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## Meet GSA's Acting Administrator: David J. Barram



David J. Barram was appointed by President Clinton as Acting Administrator of the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) on March 4, 1996, with the intent to confirm. As the number one official at GSA, Mr. Barram directs all functions assigned to this independent agency of the executive branch that employs some 16, 400 people, has an annual budget of \$11.7 billion, and financial responsibilities of \$64 billion. Mr. Barram also serves on the President's Management Council.

Created in 1949, GSA sets Federal policy in the areas of telecommunications and automated data processing, supply and service procurement, and real property management and acquisition. The agency also manages governmentwide operations in building construction, leasing and management, motor vehicle, travel and transportation management, and property disposal.

Mr. Barram comes to GSA from the Department of Commerce, where he served as Deputy Secretary and Chief Operating Officer since October 7, 1993. He directed the day-to-day operations of the 36,000 person organization. A 24-year veteran of Silicon Valley's high technology industry, Mr. Barram also played a key role in shaping and implementing the Administration's technology initiatives.

A career long businessman, Mr. Barram brings a wealth of private sector experience to his position as a chief advocate for American industry and workers. "America's global competitiveness depends upon a strong partnership between the private sector, that creates wealth and makes us strong, and the public sector, that ensures the nation's security and creates opportunity for all Americans," he has stated.

Formerly Vice President of Worldwide Corporate Affairs and Public Policies for Apple Computer, Inc., Mr. Barram joined Apple as Vice President of Finance and Chief Financial Officer. He also held the position of Vice President of Corporate Communications.

Prior to his joining Apple, Mr. Barram served as Vice President of Finance and Administration and Chief Financial Officer at Silicon Graphics, Inc. from 1983-1985. During a 13 year career with Hewlett-Packard, from 1970 to 1983, he was Controller of the Computer Products Group and held a variety of senior positions in finance and marketing.

Throughout his career, Mr. Barram has been actively involved in education issues, encouraging the use of advanced technology in the classroom and job based training. He chaired the California Commission of Public School Administrators and Leadership, publisher of the noted "Return to Greatness" report. He continues to serve as a board member of the National Center for Education and the Economy.

Mr. Barram earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Wheaton College in 1965. He holds a Master's degree in Business Administration from Santa Clara University, 1973. From 1966 to 1969, Mr. Barram was a commissioned officer in the U.S. Navy. Mr. Barram resides in Washington with his wife Joan C. Barram. Dave and Joan have two children who live in California and Oregon.



#### Household Goods Move Management Services Contract

Part IV of a VII part series pertaining to specific contract requirements and services to be performed by the Contractor under the General Services Administration (GSA) Move Management Services Contract (GS-06F-94013).

#### **PART IV**

Claims Preparation, Filing, and Settlement. The Contractor shall prepare and file immediately upon receiving information from the employee that loss or damage has occurred during the relocation of the employee's household goods. The Contractor shall prepare and file on behalf of the employee in accordance with the laws and regulations of the United States, various states, territories and possessions under which the claim is cognizable any claims for loss, damage or delay resulting from the move. The Contractor shall also provide settlement review and negotiation services in the event that the offered settlement is inconsistent with the carrier's liability or provisions of the Tender of Service (TOS). If the Contractor and carrier cannot effect a satisfactory agreement as to the settlement of the claim, the Contractor shall transmit the claim file, record of negotiation, and its findings and recommendation as to carrier liability to the employing Federal Agency for further action. Such transmittal shall be within 30 calendar days.

Preparation of the Government Bill of Lading (GBL). If requested by the Federal Agency, and if agreed to in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), the Contractor shall complete all Government Bills of Lading (GBLs), Standard Form 1103, or Privately Owned Personal Property Government Bills of Lading (PPGBLs), Standard Form 1203, for the household goods shipments handled by the Contractor for the Agency. In the event the shipment booking service involves the movement of unaccompanied air baggage (UAB) and/or authorized vehicles for offshore shipment/international shipments, the Contractor, if requested by the Agency, shall prepare separate Government Bills of Lading. In the event that a Government Bill of Lading must be amended after distribution has been made, the Contractor shall complete Standard Form 1200, Government Bill of Lading Correction Notice.

(Part V deals with Data Communications Capabilities and Storage.)

#### Direct Access Program Set for Obtaining HHG Cost Comparisons

Each day we seem to be challenged with doing more with fewer people or less time. - ---no cost to your agency for this service.

Currently, GSA has over 700 GBL issuing offices who utilize this direct access program. ## CHANGE IN FUNDING MEANS GSA FREIGHT PROGRAM MUST PAY ITS OWN WAY

The GSA freight management service program has always been free of charge to Federal customer agencies. As a result of changes in GSA's congressional funding, our transportation management function is no longer funded by direct appropriation, but rather through reimbursement from Federal customers.

The following is a copy of a letter mailed to all Federal customer agencies explaining this change in funding:

Dear Federal Customer Agency:

For the past several years, your agency has benefited from the actions of the General Services Administration (GSA) to provide you with standardized and cost effective transportation services. These services in the general freight arena include:

Publishing and maintaining the GSA Standard Tender of service (STOS).

The STOS establishes the rates, rules, and charges that surface carriers must follow in conducting business with Federal Civilian agencies. Use of the GSA STOS relieves Federal agencies of any need to (1) conduct extensive research and analysis of individual carrier tenders and tariffs to determine the most favorable charges, and (2) create, for an individual agency's use, a set of rates, rules and charges for transportation service.

Tailored requirements. GSA has offered each agency the opportunity to include their own special or unique requirements as part of the STOS. This benefits agencies in two ways: First, agencies receive deeper discounts on their special requirements because they are part of a broader transportation program, rather than part of an individual agency's procurement effort. Second, each agency's resource investment for the solicitation of freight services is minimized, while at the same time its individual needs are met.

**Reduced rates and services.** GSA by using its leveraged buying power on behalf of the Federal civilian agencies is

able to offer Federal activities significantly reduced surface transportation rates. In many instances these rates are 40 percent below the commercial market place.

**Automated Services.** GSA's development of automated freight transportation capabilities, such as rate solicitation and acceptance, provides agencies contributing to the support of the general freight program with access to special offers from carriers and pricing that applies to particular routes.

Use of GSA's Automated Rate Filing and Retrieval System (ARFARS). This totally automated system helps agencies ensure that they receive the most accurate, up-to-date, rate information in a timely manner via its automated cost comparison system. If an agency did not have access to ARFARS, GSA Zone Transportation Offices provided the agency with shipment pricing and routing.

**Representation.** GSA represent Federal civilian agencies' transportation interests before carriers, carrier trade associations, and other organizations representing the transportation industry.

This servicing policy is changing May 1, of this year. As a result of changes in our Congressional funding, GSA's transportation management function is no longer funded by direct appropriations, but rather through reimbursement from using Federal activities. Since GSA must recover administrative management cost for these services for the entire 1996 fiscal year, transportation management funding agreements consummated between October 1, 1995 and September 30, 1996, will be retroactive to October 1, 1995. Therefore, effective May 1, 1996, GSA is no longer providing these and other freight services at "no cost." The upcoming reissuance of the STOS and rate solicitation issued January 19, 1996, with an effective date of May 1, 1996, will benefit only those Federal customer agencies that have agreed to pay GSA for the transportation services identified above.

Agencies that do not enter into funding agreements with GSA for transportation services will need to solicit their own freight transportation services and negotiate for discounted rates. Under the terms of the Transportation Regulatory Act of 1994, and further changes contemplated with the sunsetting of the Interstate Commerce Commission, freight carriers are free to offer shippers any rates and menu of services they choose. Consequently, agencies not presently party to a funding agreement with GSA have three alternatives.

First, since GSA's STOS and negotiated rates/services provided pursuant to it will not be available after April 30, 1996, non-participating agencies will need to develop their own statement of work, conduct negotiations with individual carriers, and establish fair and reasonable acceptance criteria.

Second, agencies may continue to access ARFARS for rate and route information, but will only have access to those carriers quoting 100% of the STOS baseline rates and charges. If a shipment is made via one of these carriers, the full STOS rates, charges, and rules will apply to the shipment.

**Third,** agencies may subscribe to GSA's STOS program, including individualized rate solicitation.

## **New Delivery Services On the Horizon**

The February Marketips contained an article explaining that GSA was planning to canvass our customers for express freight and international express small package requirements. To update this project, Federal agencies/organizations within the next month can expect a letter from GSA explaining the three delivery services which are next and second business day delivery of freight and international delivery of small packages.

Both the freight delivery services and the international small package delivery service will provide a delivery service consistent with that which is provided to commercial customers.

The letter will also request shipment volume data as well as other information necessary for GSA to begin the procurement process. It will be helpful if our GSA customer agencies and organizations needing this service could begin to accumulate data on the following subjects:

- Number of shipments by weight break for FY 1995, for each proposed delivery service.
- Net dollars spent by weight break for FY 1995, for each proposed delivery service.
- Transportation companies used to provide the proposed delivery service.
- International locations where deliveries are made.

GSA (under separate letter) will request agencies and organizations to commit to being a mandatory user of the proposed delivery services. By doing this GSA is in a much stronger position to receive competitive rates with the highest quality service.

#### PARTIAL WITHDRAWALS FROM STORAGE-IN-TRANSIT (SIT)

Many times employees ask the question whether or not they may withdraw articles from temporary storage. The withdrawal of articles from storage is allowable. However, to minimize the expense and the amount of time that the warehouse worker handles your household goods and personal effects, advance notification and planning is encouraged. For example, articles that may be withdrawn from SIT at a later date should be identified by the property owner/agent at the time of packing, whenever possible.

If the shipment has already been packed, inventory numbers should be furnished by the property owner to the Government Bill of Lading Officer (GBLIO), who should then provide the information to the carrier. Only complete cartons or item numbers on the inventory may be withdrawn. Individual cartons should not be opened. Partial withdrawals from SIT should only be ordered by the GBLIO who shall certify on the DD Form 619-1 or comparable commercial form. Employees should be fully aware of their liability for any additional costs, such as labor, and/or warehouse handling cost, incurred for the partial withdraw of items from SIT. For billing purposes, the carrier is responsible for obtaining the weight of the portion withdrawn. **Contact: Richard J. Johnson, Jr., at (816)823-3646 or Fax (816)823-3646.** 

## GSA, DFAS Agree On Unused Tickets

On October 31, 1996 the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS), Directorate for Transporation Payments, and the General Services Administration, Office of Transportation Audits executed a memorandum of understanding transferring the responsibility for processing and collecting unused airline tickets to GSA. The Military Traffic Management Command and the military services have been notified of this change and have been instructed to forward unused tickets to GSA for handling. Refunds collected will be returned to DFAS or the United States Treasury, depending on the individual circumstances. 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## The Good News, the Bad News...

The figures are in for Fiscal Year 1995, and by almost all measures it was a good year for the JWOD Program, which generates employment and training for people who are blind or severely disabled through Federal purchases of supplies and services. The program experienced moderate growth, which is particularly gratifying during this time of Federal downsizing, budget cutting, and (erroneous) perceptions that required sources of supply have been bypassed by procurement reform.

During FY95, the JWOD Program provided employment opportunities to 29,752 people with disabilities. These employees worked over 23 million direct labor hours, and their wages totaled more than \$141 million. The average hourly wage earned by JWOD employees was

\$6.11, well above the Federal minimum wage of \$4.25. There are now over 600 nonprofit agencies participating in the JWOD Program, and their total sales to the Government surpassed \$675 million last year.

However, anecdotal evidence tells us that some business is being lost. Although several new products have been added to the JWOD Program, sluggish office supply sales have caused a few nonprofit agencies to temporarily lay off workers with disabilities. This downturn may be attributed to either (or both) the smaller workforce or local purchases of commercial supplies which are identical or essentially the same as JWOD items. Efforts to raise awareness of the JWOD Program continue in order to curtail the latter, which not only violates the JWOD

Act, but deprives people with disabilities of much needed jobs.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind all Federal employees that using a Governmentwide IMPAC Purchase Card does not exempt personnel from the requirement to buy JWOD supplies. Instead, you can use the IMPAC Card as a payment method when ordering JWOD items from your local GSA Customer Supply Center. Also, please keep in mind that recent reform legislation does not waive the statutory requirement to buy JWOD products, regardless of how small the dollar value of the purchase. This means that "micropurchasing authority" may not be used to buy commercially available items that are essentially the same as JWOD items.
