

Woburn. **BALDWIN, LOAMMI, MANSION**, 2 Alfred St., c. 1750. Frame, flush horizontal siding; 3 stories, hipped roof with low central monitor, 2 interior chimneys, modillion cornice; corner pilasters; center entrance with tracery side lights and fanlight, partially set within broken pediment supported by flanking pilasters, entrance and Palladian window above probably added later; rear ell added, c. 1820; moved; under restoration. Georgian and Federal elements. Home of Col. Loammi Baldwin, builder of the Middlesex Canal (see also Middlesex Canal, MA), and of Loammi Baldwin, Jr., father of American civil engineering. *Municipal*: HABS; G.
