Sunny yellow flowers with a brown cental disk. Can reach 9', but more often is shorter. Tolerates wet or dry, but requires lots of sun.

Suggested companions: big bluestem (Andropogon gerardii), switch grass (Panicum virgatum), New England aster (Aster novae-angliae), blazing star (Liatris spicata), blue vervain (Verbena hastata), ironweed (Vernonia missurica)
