A Saturday editorial on the 2002 Klamath Basin salmon kill misidentified the Interior Department agency responsible for managing water in the region. It is the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation.

The Oregonian asserted in a June 24 editorial that the Bonneville Power Administration had kept secret an emergency decision April 3 to spill more water over dams when it ran short of electricity, potentially imperiling protected salmon. While the BPA did not contact a federal judge overseeing salmon recovery, it did inform federal fisheries agencies and a technical advisory team that includes fisheries interests from the four Northwest states.

Sen. Joseph McCarthy had no involvement with the House Committee on Un-American Activities during the 1950s. A commentary article on Monday's Editorial page was incorrect in that regard. McCarthy's investigations were separate from the House committee.
