

Chickamauga. **GORDON-LEE HOUSE**, 217 Cove Rd, c. 1840-1847. Brick, coursed stone foundation; 2 stories, L-shaped; 1st- and 2nd- story front center entrances, each with transom and sidelights, 2nd-story balcony with chinoiserie balustrade; 2-story Doric front portico and side porch added, 1900; numerous outbuildings. Greek Revival and Neo-Classical Revival elements. Built with slave labor for plantation owner James Gordon; home of his grandson, U.S. Congressman Gordon Lee; headquarters of Union Maj. Gen. William Rosecrans before 1863 Battle of Chickamauga. *Private*.
