EPA has approved the final report "Summary of Existing Information and Identification of Data Gaps Report", January 15, 2004, prepared by Striplin Environmental Associates for the City of Seattle and King County. Recently, the following erratum was identified.

In Section 5.1.3.2, the final document states: "Sediments that meet the SQS criteria are expected to have no adverse effects on biological resources and **pose no significant risks to** human health." This language is incorrect as the SMS criteria are specifically designed with regards to protection of environmental receptors.

The sentence should read: "Sediments that meet the SQS criteria are expected to have no adverse effects on biological resources and pose no significant risks to human health."
