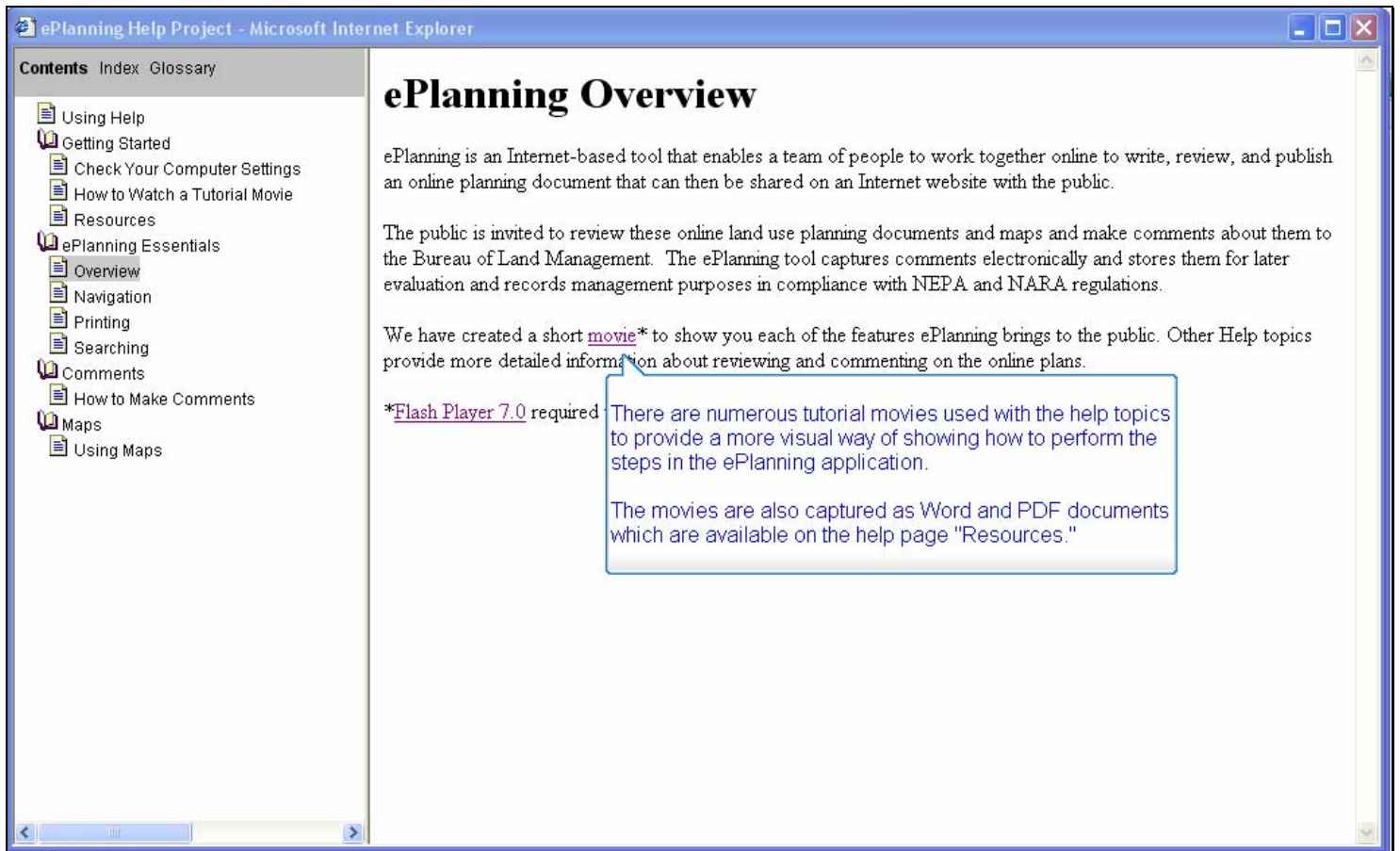

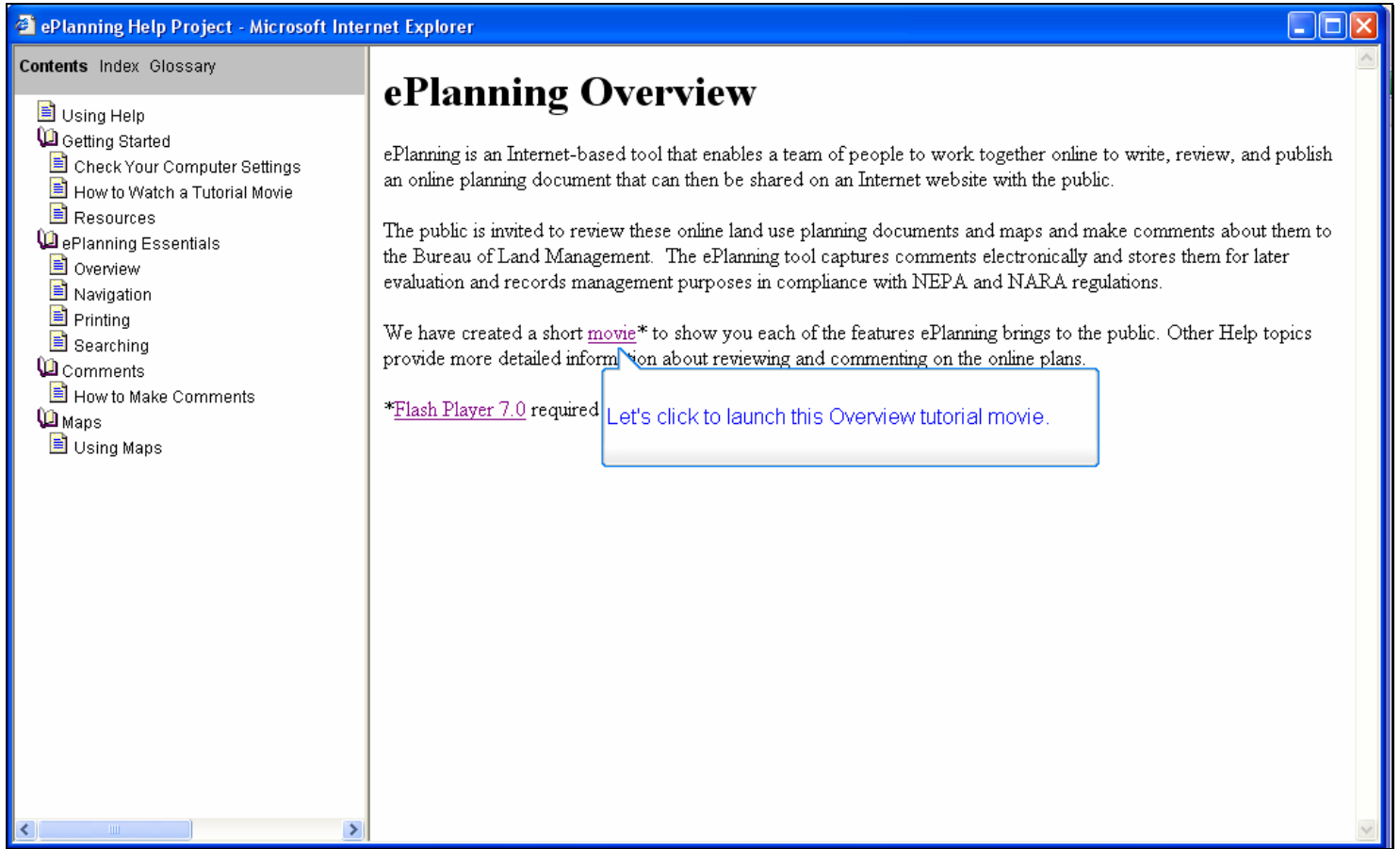

The movies are also captured as Word and PDF documents which are available on the help page "Resources."

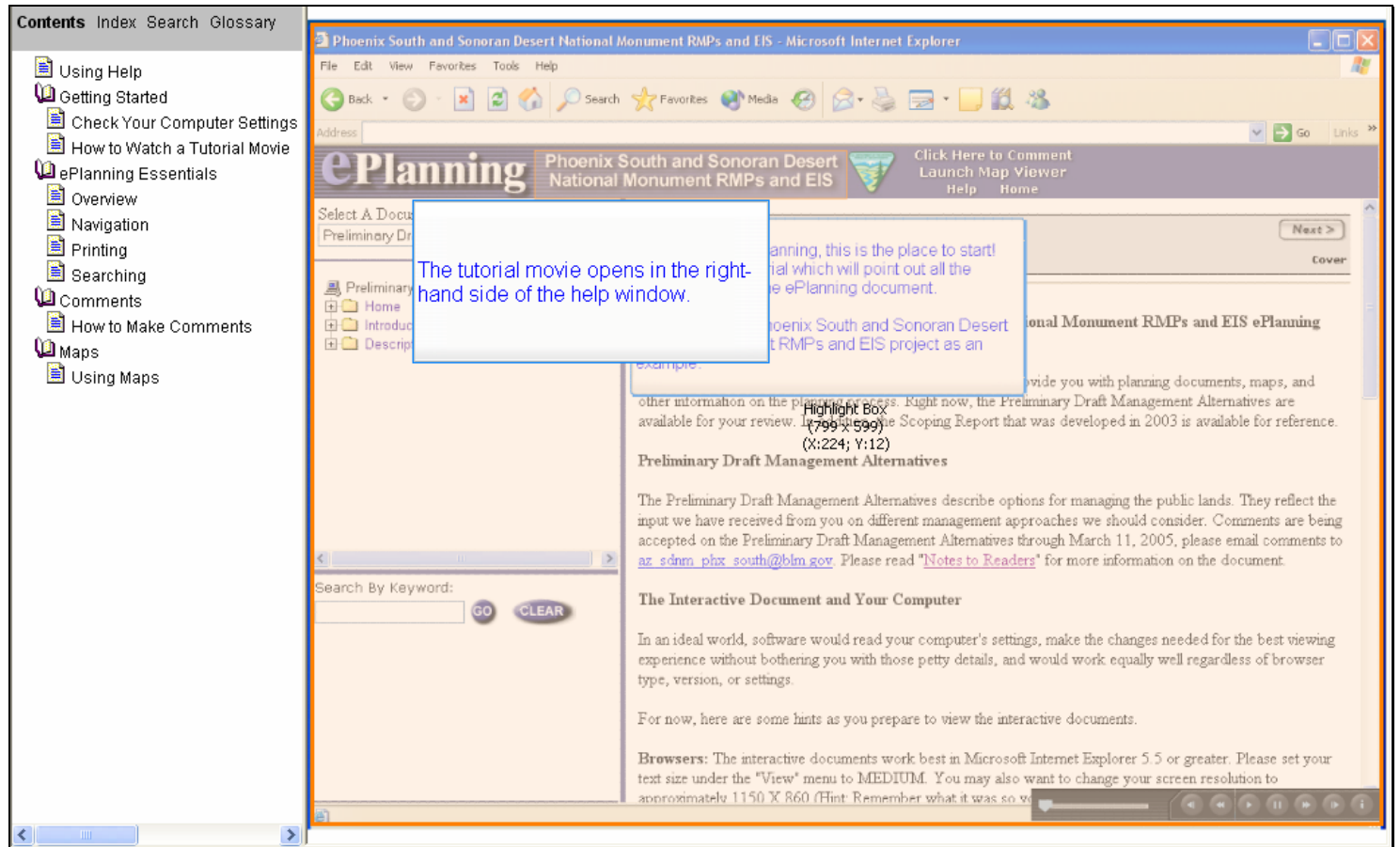

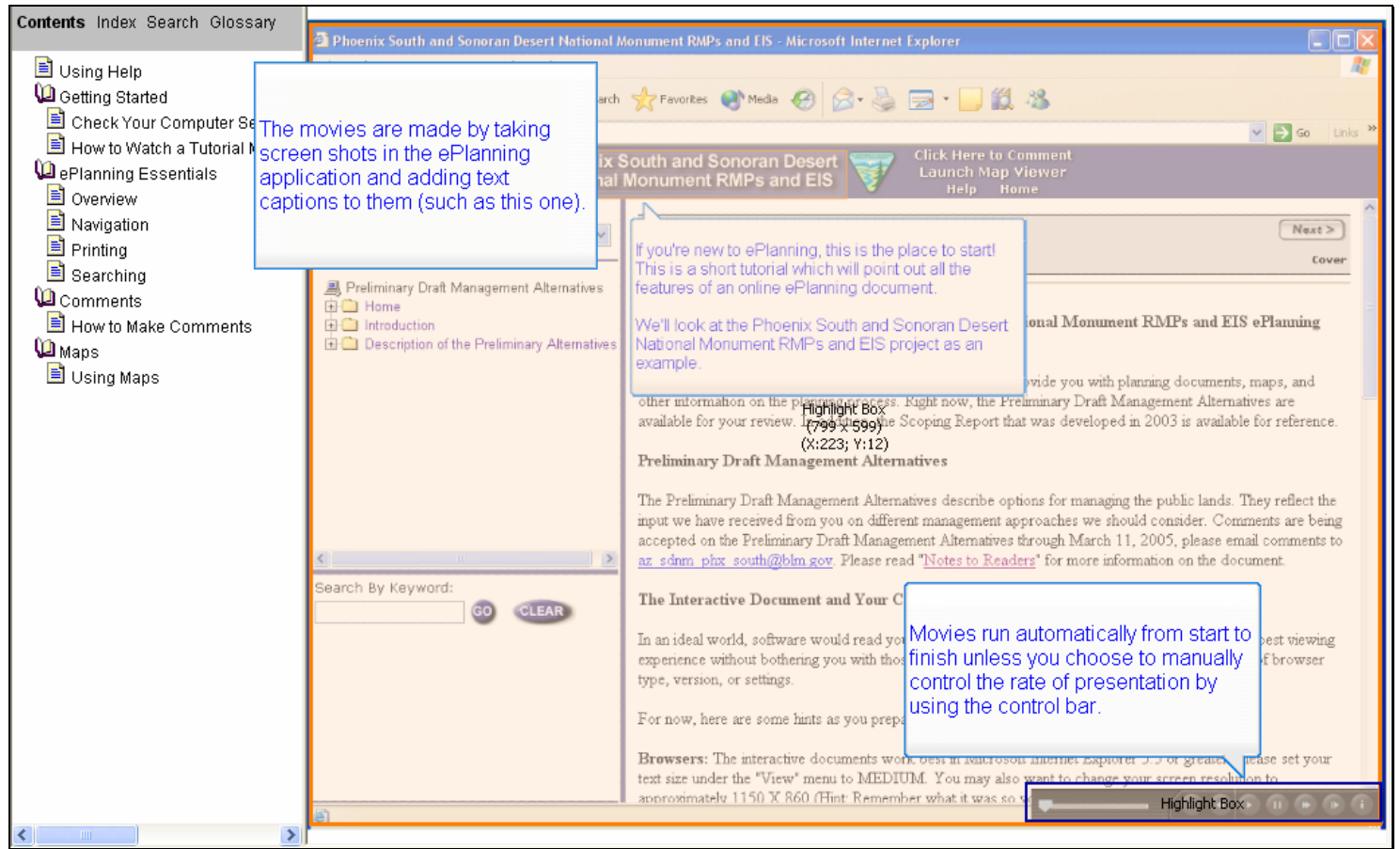

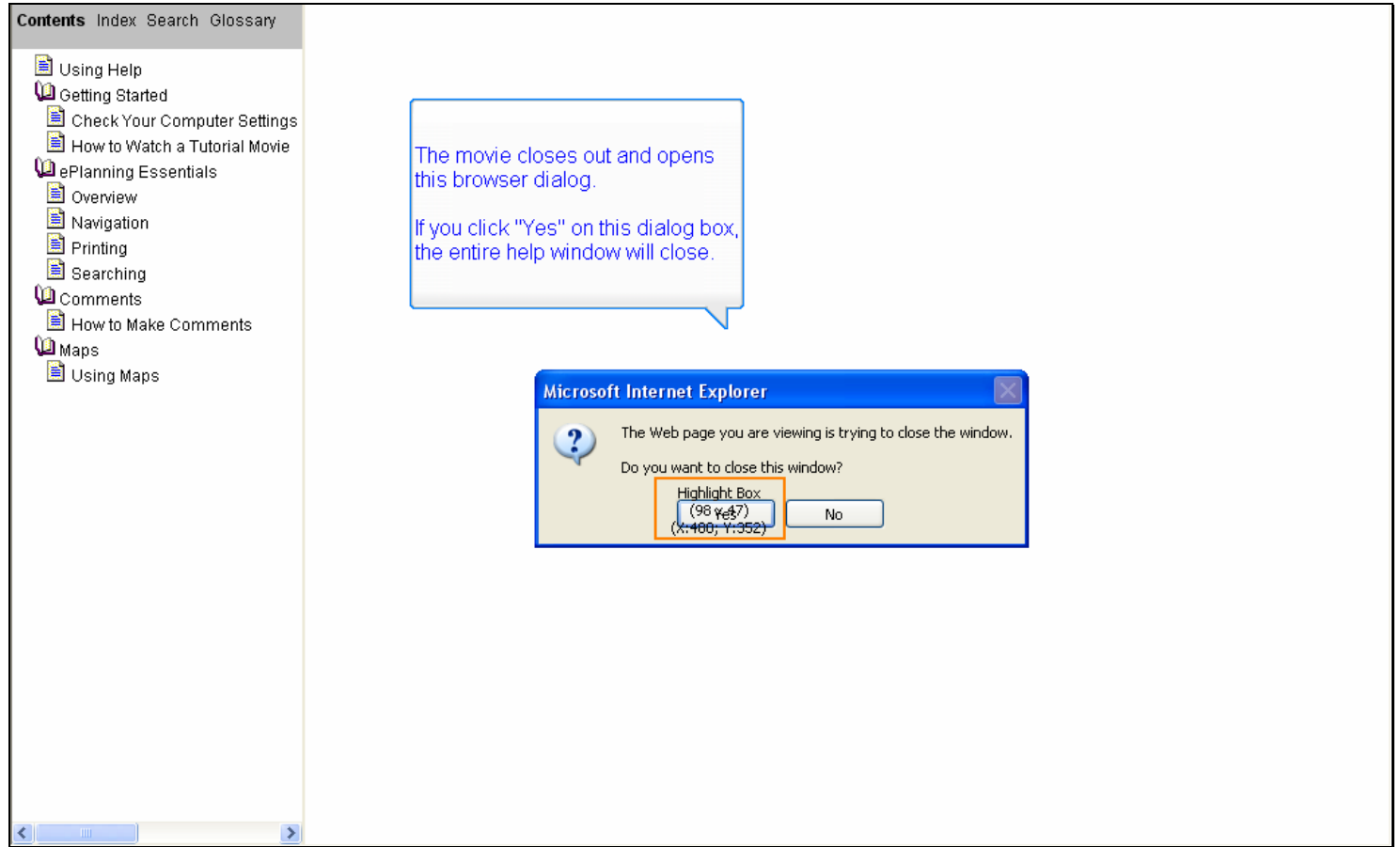

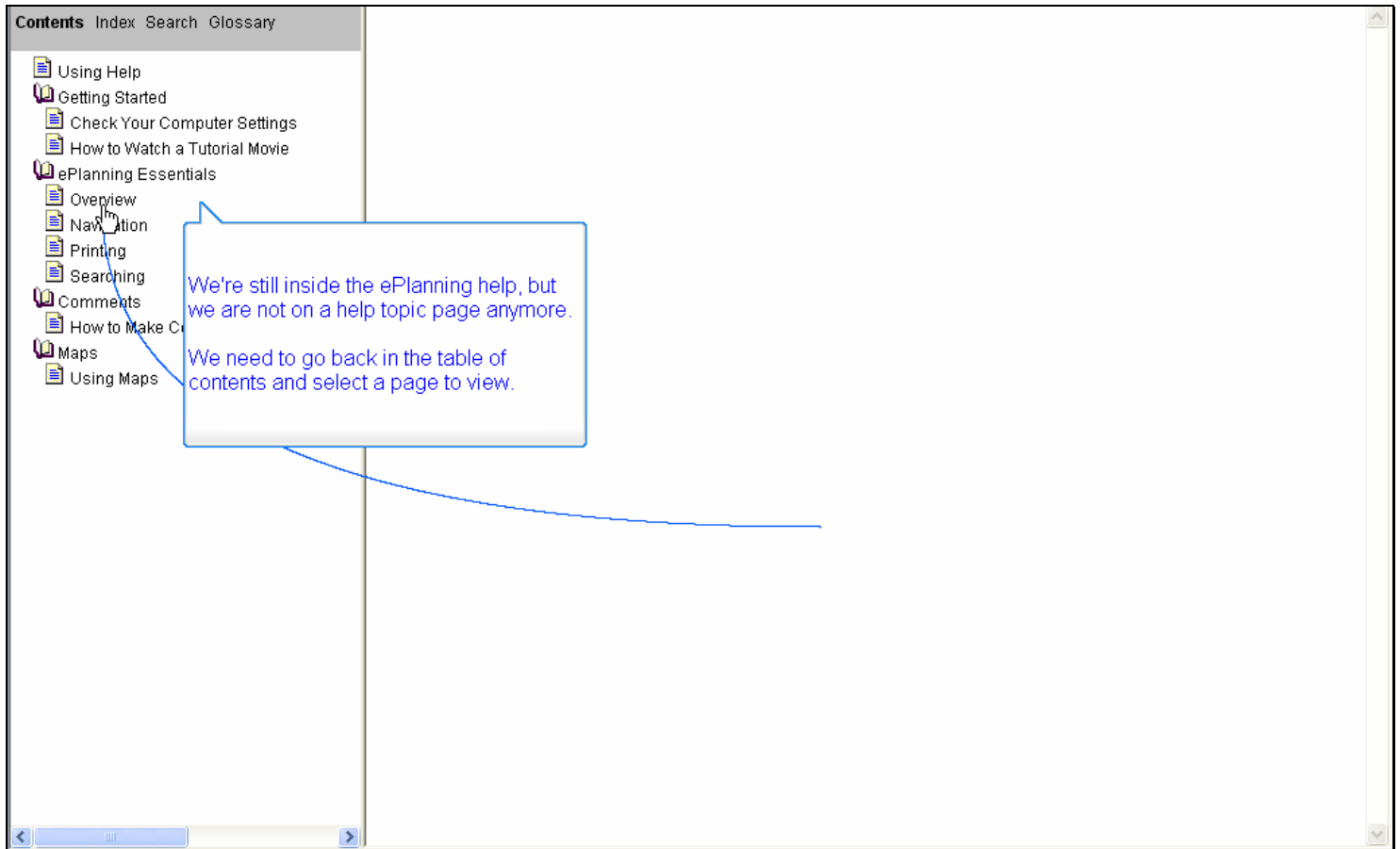

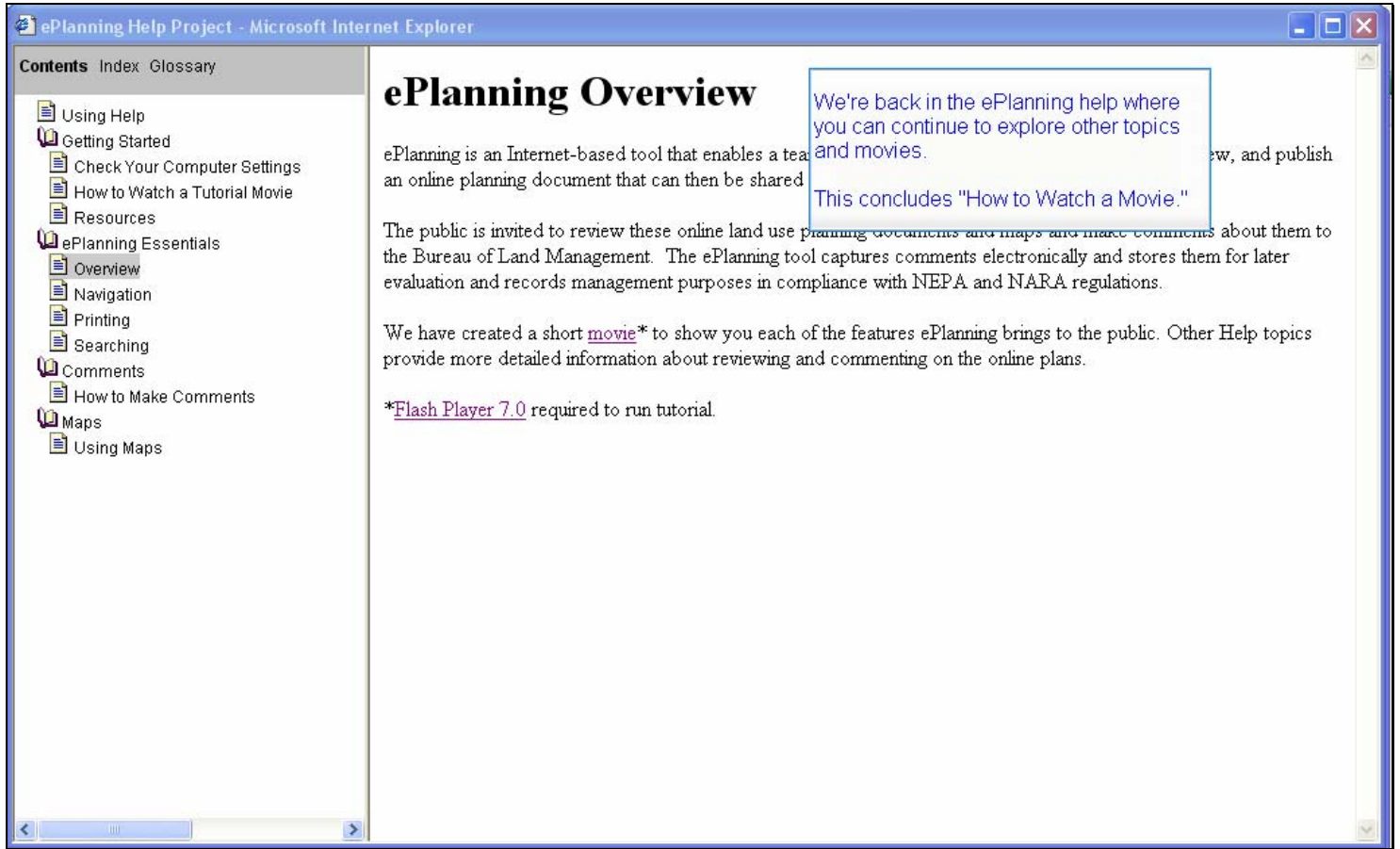
