4 Zones: We see no need to change the SHGC requirements for the North Central zone from 0.40 to 0.55. This area still has a need to control SHGC for skylights., NC, VA, TN. Our proposal/comment is to make the SHGC in the North Central 0.40. As I review the evaluations, it is all pertaining to vertical glazing, right? Since the SHGC performance for skylights is not effected by overhang/shading, then the addition of one skylight at 0.55 can change the overall SHGC for the building envelope.
