Title, language and number of pages of the notified document: Draft Commission Directive amending Annexes II, III, IV and V to Council Directive 2000/29/EC on protective measures against the introduction into the Community of organisms harmful to plants or plant products and against their spread within the Community (22 pages).
- **6. Description of content:** The current provisions governing the import into and movement within the Community of woods and wood products are proposed to be amended.

In particular, the relevant provisions of Directive 2000/29/EC on wood packaging material would be aligned with the provisions of the FAO International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures No 15 on *Guidelines for regulating wood packaging material in international trade*.

Other amendments are proposed as regards:

- wood originating in countries where *Bursaphelenchus xylophilus* (Steiner et Bührer) Nickle *et al.* is known to occur:
- wood originating in Russia, Kazakhstan and Turkey and other third countries;
- isolated bark of conifers;
- the provisions against *Cryphonectria parasitica* (Murrill.) Barr.;
- changes in the tariff and statistical nomenclature and the Common Customs Tariff.

These amended provisions are of interest for member States and countries exporting the relevant wood or wood products to the European Community.
