Changes to Miscellaneous Fee Schedule

On September 19, 2006, the Judicial Conference approved several changes to the Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule relating to implementation of the Bankruptcy Abuse and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (BAPCPA) and the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005. The changes to the following fees will become effective on January 1, 2007.

^{*}Note: Filer must first file the direct appeal or cross appeal for a fee of \$255.00. Once the direct appeal is authorized, an **additional** \$200.00 is due.
