

Forest Glen. **NATIONAL PARK SEMINARY HISTORIC DISTRICT**, Linden Lane near I 495, 1890-20th C. Imaginative educational complex converted for hospital use, includes many fanciful structures displaying numerous international building elements; notable are the Forest Inn (1890), a 2-story stuccoed structure with half-timbered effect and large verandas, the Greek Revival Odeon Theater, and the pagoda and windmill sorority houses; also features covered walkways and outdoor sculptures, remains of original elaborately planned formal gardens. Original resort inn purchased by Dr. John Cassedy (1894) and converted into seminary for women; expanded into junior college, 1930's; purchased by U.S. Army and made part of Walter Reed Army Hospital, 1942. *Federal/USA*.
