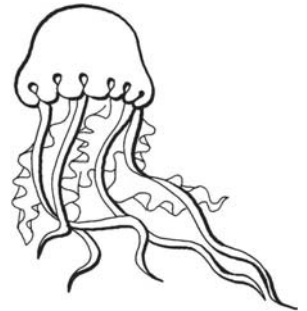

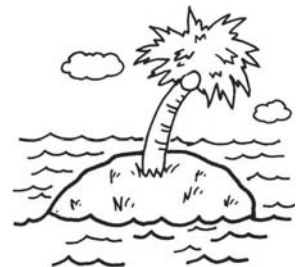


## February 1 *"Treasure Island"*
