

PORTLAND, Ore. — Five students from <u>Lakeridge High School</u> proved their intellectual strength in the Bonneville Power Administration's Regional High School <u>Science Bowl</u>, Saturday, March 7, at the University of Portland. Team A from Lakeridge didn't lose a match during the all-day quiz-show-style competition and beat <u>South Umpqua High School</u> 74-22 in the final round.

The Lakeridge team of captain Sarah Perry, Kenji Sasaki, Quinn Minor, Daren Chow and Jillian Smythe will go on to compete in the Department of Energy-sponsored National Science Bowl in Washington, D. C., May 1-4.

Sixty-four teams from Oregon and Washington high schools competed in the round robin tournament early Saturday morning. Only 16 teams remained in the running by 1:30 p.m. In the end, the final four schools, all from Oregon, included Lakeridge claming first place, South Umpqua holding on to second, West Linn High School capturing third and Team A from Beaverton High School taking fourth place.
