General Comment: There are some very troubling issues with the Proposed Order. Specifically, it appears

that the Proposed Order is nothing more than a political move by packers and importers

to gain control. Under the Current Order, the Honey Board has both significant representation by domestic honey producers and focus on domestic honey production.

The Board under the Proposed Order will be dominated by packers and importers and

the voice of domestic producers under the Proposed Order will be effectively silenced:

marginalized to just three seats on the proposed Board whereas they currently occupy

seven seats on the current Board.

Given the importance of domestic honey production, and given the importance of the

honey bee to U.S. agriculture, especially as underscored by the recent emergence of

Colony Collapse Disorder, is it vitally important that the Dept. of Agriculture continue to

support and encourage domestic honey production. The Proposed Order is contrary to

these goals and I urge that it be rejected.
