She also supports the Homeless Veterans Assistance Act of 2001 (HR 2716). This bill calls for the elimination of homelessness among veterans within 10 years. It increases funding for a number of existing veterans homeless programs, and includes programs though the department of Housing and Urban Development and the Labor Department in addition to including medical care for homeless veterans with special needs.
