

Concord-Lexington vicinity. **MINUTE MAN NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK**, From Concord to Lexington on MA 2A, 1775. North Bridge, Minute Man statue, and 4 miles of Battle Rd. between Lexington and Concord. Part of route that British marched from Boston to Concord to confiscate cache of colonial arms, and site of engagement between British and Americans which, with the battle at Lexington, began the armed conflict of the Revolution, Apr. 19, 1775. first shot at Concord called by Emerson “the shot heard round the world.” Statue was first major work of sculptor Daniel 1843; Chester French, and was completed for America’s Centennial celebration, 1875. Park also includes The Wayside, home of American author Nathaniel Hawthorne. *Federal/NPS/non-federal*: HABS
