

120,512 acres in 2002, 100,883 acres in 1997, up 19 percent.

Average size of farm

134 acres in 2002, 126 acres in 1997, up 6 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$27,012,000 in 2002, \$19,777,000 in 1997, up 37 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$8,732,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$18,280,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$29,946 in 2002, \$24,752 in 1997, up 21 percent.


