The Friends of Wheeler National Wildlife Refuge Association is hosting Clean Up and Learn Days throughout 2007 to clean and pick up litter around areas in the Wheeler National Wildlife Refuge while promoting multi-use opportunities on the Refuge.

On **Saturday, April 7, 2007**, at **8:30 a.m.** please join us for our Clean Up & Learn Day at the lower end of **White Springs Dike**...



From 8:30-9:30 a.m. we'll Clean Up around the shoreline and parking area. Garbage bags and gloves will be provided. Afterwards, we'll take a 7 mile mountain biking trip through the Refuge. The trail is a little bumpy in some areas so a mountain bike (with fatter tires) will be needed rather than the typical 10-speed road bike. Along the way we hope to see a wide variety of flora and fauna including spring wildflowers, waterfowl, and maybe even a whitetail deer. We plan to finish biking by noon.

Directions: On I-565 west of Huntsville, take Exit #2 for Mooresville. Travel .1 mile south to the Old AL Hwy 20. Turn right and go .7 mile. Turn left (south) on gravel road (Arrowhead Landing Road) and follow this road for 1.6 miles. Take the left fork at the Wheeler NWR entrance sign, and travel another .6 miles to the lower end of White Springs Dike (just south of Arrowhead Landing—North Alabama Birding Trail Site #23).
