

Grand Rapids. **PIKE, ABRAM W., HOUSE, (GRAND RAPIDS ART MUSEUM) MI**, 230  
Fulton St., E, 1844-1845. Frame clapboarding; 2-story central mass with symmetrical 1-story  
hipped wings, square, gabled roof, tall interior chimney, 2-story pedimented tetrastyle Doric  
portico, off-center entrance with transom, large brick rear addition (1920's). Greek Revival. Built  
for Abram Pike, prominent Grand Rapids' merchant. Museum. *Private*: HABS.
