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## Uzbekistan, Republic of **Cotton and Products Cotton Production Update** 2003

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#### **Report Highlights:**

Uzbekistan's MY 2003/04 cotton crop has been hampered by weather and pest infestation problems. Due to abovementioned problems, MY 2003/04 cotton production is forecast at 930,000 MT with exports declining to 680,000 MT.

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### **PRODUCTION**

MY 2003/04 cotton production is forecast to decline further to 930,000 MT due to heavy rainfall in mid spring which necessitated considerable area replanting in almost all cotton growing regions. As a result, this delayed the beginning of the harvest at least for two weeks negatively impacting the crop. According to various sources, several major cotton growing regions suffered from serious pest infestation, in particular bollworm and cotton noctuid. Some experts believe this infestation problem may deteriorate fiber quality. Some regions started harvesting in mid-September.

In order to encourage cotton farmers, the government of Uzbekistan (GOU) recently adopted a decree which gives the farmers the right to sell seed cotton over quota at a negotiated price which is 20 percent higher than the fixed state procurement price. Also, the Ministry of Agriculture and Water Resources and the Ministry of Finance were tasked by the GOU to set up the new crop's procurement price of cotton taking into account the current world market prices. According to this decree, the state will pay for hand-picked and machine picked seed cotton at 10 percent higher than the last year's crop.

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#### **TRADE**

MY 2003/04 cotton exports are forecast to decline to 680,000 MT assuming normal weather for the remainder of the growing and harvesting season. In spite of new regulations, the GOU still controls exports of both state-order cotton and over-quota free cotton through the trading companies of the Agency for Foreign Economic Relations (AFER) which coordinates sales, export prices and shipments.

Most cotton from the new crop will be still sold to international buyers through negotiated sales although recently AFER launched several small auctions with limited success. According to a new resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers, this year about 30,000 tons of cotton have been allocated for export sale by Uzauctionsavdo. According to various sources Uzauctionsavdo will also handle domestic sales of cotton to local textile mills.
