**COMMENTS IN PROTEST**

As a resident of Washington County, I appreciate the opportunity provided to submit comments regarding the National Interest Electric Transmission Corridor (NIETC) for the draft Mid-Atlantic Area National Corridor.

1. I understand Allegheny Power and their partners are trying to limit the Public Utility Commission (PUC) reviews by seeking NIETC designation. The NIETC designation would provide Allegheny Power to take rights-of-way under federal eminent domain affecting not only my property, but also all properties in Washington County.
2. The Mid-Atlantic Area National Corridor covers a massive geographic area that extends well beyond the "Critical Congestion Areas" that have been identified.

The draft Mid-Atlantic Area National Corridor should only contain the areas identified as the "Critical Congestion Areas".

3. The designation of the current proposal of the Mid-Atlantic National Corridor Area would initiate a safety hazard to its surrounding lands that cannot be assured, nor reasonably protected, and which represents what could be a Homeland Security "attractive nuisance" to our Commonwealth, our families and our local communities.
4. The economic vitality and development in the proposed Mid-Atlantic National Corridor would be constrained by the lack of adequate or reasonably priced electricity, resulting in economic decline.

### CONCLUSION

**As a resident of Washington County, I respectfully request the U.S. Department of Energy to consider my comments in PROTEST, and DENY the proposed draft Mid-Atlantic Area National Corridor designation.**
