

CANADIAN EMBASSY (MOORE HOUSE), 1746 Massachusetts Ave., NW., 1906, Price and de Sibour, architects. Brick, stone 1st floor; 4 1/2 stories, rectangular, modified mansard roof, interior chimneys, segmental arched dormers, recessed center entrance; round arched 2nd-story windows, each with a stone balcony; 3rd-story iron balconies, quoined window surrounds modillion cornice, decorative classical detailing. Beaux-Arts Classical. Built for Mabel Swift Moore, Swift family heiress. *Private; not accessible to the public.*
