

Jacksonville. **OLD ST. LUKE'S HOSPITAL**, 314 N. Palmetto St., 1878. Brick, 2 1/2 stories, modified rectangle, overhanging hipped roof with deck and small cupola, center gable with paired round arched windows, center entrance with transom, segmental arches over windows, small attic windows above belt course; original 2-story portico and elaborate cupola removed. City's oldest hospital building, built to provide for penniless or ill travelers; served yellow-fever victims in 1888 epidemic. *Private.*
