(1634) Lowell, Jophanus J. Private. Co.G, 17 ME. Age - 18. Occ - Farmer. Res - Farmington, ME. Mustered 18 Aug, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 11 Feb, 1863 at a regimental hospital near Falmouth (SR). Mentioned in <u>Red Diamond Regiment: The 17th Maine Infantry, 1862-1865</u>. Originally buried at Mackey's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(**4681B**) Lucas, John A. Private. Co.C, 542 Va. Engineers Service Batt. Discharged 25 Oct., 1919. Died 16 Jan, 1936.

(1965) Luckany, L.J. Private. U.S. Vol. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1463) Lundy, William W. Private. Co.A, 139 PA. Mustered 1 Sept, 1862 for three years. Killed at Marye's Heights 3 May, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Thomas Morrison's Lot, Fredericksburg(ROH).

Died 14 May, 1864 of wounds received in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5883) Lutz, Michael Private. Co.I, 145 NY. Enlisted at New York City for three years and mustered in 11 Sept, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 27 Mar, 1863 at 2nd Div., 12th Corps. Hospital (SR). Originally buried at Harris's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3799) Lutz, William Private. Co.D, 91 PA. Enlisted and mustered in 18 Feb, 1864 at Philadelphia for three years. Died 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(**3592**) Lyle, Charles Private. Co.F, 105 PA. Mustered in 29 Jan, 1864 for three years. Killed at the Wilderness 5 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1030) Lytle, Benjamin C.Private. Co.D, 149 PA. (drafted). Mustered in 18 Aug, 1863. Died 17 May, 1864 of wounds received at Spotsylvania Court House 9 May, 1864 (SR). A ball entered his shoulder, passing downward towards his back (Reg). Originally buried at Gale's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).
