#### ARKANSAS HIGHLIGHTS

Winter wheat production in Arkansas as of May 1, 2004 is forecast at 32.1 million bushels, up 13 percent from the 2003 crop of 28.5 million bushels. The average yield is expected to be 51 bushels per acre, up 1 bushel per acre from the previous year. Wheat growers expect to harvest 630,000 acres this year, up 11 percent from last year's 570,000 acres. The final estimate of Arkansas cotton production for 2003 totaled 1,804,000 bales, up 8 percent from 2002. Yield averaged a record high 916 pounds of lint per acre, up 45 pounds per acre from the 871 pounds per acre in 2002, and up 39 lbs. per acre from the previous record high yield of 877 lbs per acre set in 1994. Cotton growers harvested 945,000 acres, up 25,000 acres from a year ago. All hay stocks on Arkansas farms on May 1, 2004 totaled 600,000 tons, up 2 percent from the May 1, 2003 stocks of 588,000 tons.

### **U.S. HIGHLIGHTS**

Winter wheat production as of May 1, 2004, is

forecast at 1.55 billion bushels, down 9 percent from 2003. Yield is forecast at 44.2 bushels per acre, 2.5 bushels less than last year. Grain area totals 35.1 million acres, down 4 percent from last season.

Cotton production totaled 18.3 million bales in 2003, up 6 percent from the 2002 production. The area planted to all cotton totaled 13.5 million acres, down 3 percent from 2002, and harvested area, at 11.8 million acres, decreased 3 percent. Yields for the U.S. averaged 730 pounds per harvested acre. The U.S. yield for upland cotton is a record high 723 pounds per acre. Hay stocks on farms May 1, 2004 totaled 25.9 million tons, up17 percent from the previous year. This increase was mainly the result of a higher hay production in 2003.
